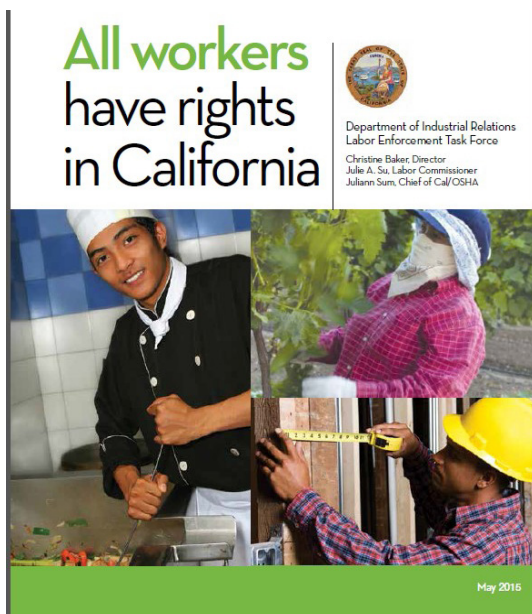

- Do you want to learn how to help workers file effective claims with government agencies?

Labor Occupational Health Program is offering a workshop on basic workers' rights such as minimum wage and overtime, meal and rest breaks, health and safety, workers' compensation, and protection from retaliation. Workshops will feature sample activities to teach basic labor rights, share resources for helping workers address problems and file successful claims, and provide copies of "All Workers Have Rights in California" to use in outreach and education efforts.

This workshop supports the work of the Department of Industrial Relations Labor Enforcement Task-force (LETF). LETF aims to make sure that workers are paid their full wages, workplaces are safe, and employers are complying with labor and payroll tax laws.

Participants may receive a \$60 stipend if needed to attend.
